KEY GOALS OF CPC SESSION:

This meeting focused on:

INSIGHTS

Key feedback from CPC on the comprehensive feedback so far:

- Overall positive response from CPC noted
- A few voiced need to do more to reach minority communities
- Mention of how attending some community events would have worked better if directly stationed inside the event rather than at/past the perimeter





- Discussion had on engagement moving 'at the speed of trust' City noted that they are trying and also very open to CPC's and others' support to reach more people
- City suggested that concerned CPC members send in more detailed ideas/solutions directly to them - said always open door

Key feedback from CPC on Meeting in a Box:

- A number of CPC members will try to host a Meeting in a Box
- It was noted that those leading Meeting in a Box will receive compensation
